Learning Curriculum

Those methodologies are a departure from the traditional rote learning that is imparted in most schools. While the syllabus for each grade is structured, teachers have the autonomy and flexibility to design the curriculum. The Curriculum Coordinator assists and supports teachers in the choice of materials and methodology. It is also the former's responsibility to shape and integrade online-offline learning, as well as the formal and informal curriculum.

Development of Multiple Intelligences

We believe that intelligence is not a single phenomenon of the human mind. To typecast all humans on a single general intelligence quotient has largely been responsible for an urgency to cram and score high marks. Human intellectual competencies are broadly divided into multiple intelligences. As such, the curriculum at SCM has been specifically designed to enable each and every student to hone his/her respective intelligences.

Linguistic Intelligence : Developed through creative writing, poetry, foreign languages, communication skills, public speaking and audio-visual room.

Musical Intelligence : Through developing a "tonal mind" by learning and composing classical and contemporary music.

Spatial Intelligence : Photography, sculpture, painting and drawing enables students to develop a sense of space, mental imagery and the ability to think and express visually and creatively.

Bodily-Kinesthetic Intelligence: By developing the "Language of the body" and bodily skills through dance, theatre-ineducation, sports and athletics.

Logical-Mathematical Intelligence : Through Maths and Science Labs with Biotechnology being integrated in the curriculum and Commercial Designing.

Interpersonal-social Intelligence : Capacity to detect and respond appropriately to the moods, motivations and desires of others (involved in understanding of others and one's relations to others. Being high in social skills)

Intrapersonal-intuitive Intelligence: Capacity to be self-aware and in tune with inner feelings, values, beliefs and thinking processes (involved in understanding oneself and having insight into one's own thoughts, actions and emotions)

Naturalist Intelligence: Ability to recognize and categorize plants, animals and other objects in nature (This intelligence involves the ability to understand and work effectively in the natural world. This is exemplified by biologists and zoologists), through Eco Friendly environment.

Student Centric Learning

Focus on teacher-centric instruction reduces students to passive recipients of knowledge. Traditional teaching is a one-way street, where teachers teach and students learn by rote. Hence, we create an environment in which students are systematically encouraged to continually seek their own learning. Our teachers play the role of "facilitators".

Project-Based Learning

Students are assigned individual projects in their areas of specific intelligence to develop and hone their skills and respective intelligences.

Creativity-Centered Learning

Apart from regular learning in all disciplines, the School provides Computer Clubs for creative learning. Students are given the opportunity to acquire digital fluency and are encouraged to go beyond accessing information. Why is Alternatives to homework given importance in SCM?

In the present educational scenario of the country, the emphasis on formal learning has become so much that the importance and joy of learning is getting marginalized. The School believes that the time available to the students at home especially at the primary level, can be meaningfully used for development of cord skills which would enable them to look at the broader perspectives of life. These core skills would help them face life with greater self-confidence.

At the early stages skills have to be developed for making the child an all rounder. These skills can be inculcated with small play activities at home with parents. Mode of Fee Payment & Withdrawls

It is mandatory to pay the fees for the entire 12 months.

School fees will have to be deposited in 4 installments of 3 months each and should be fully deposited to be paid by the 7th of month April, July, Oct, Jan, Failing which a fine of Rs 5/- Per day will be charged. If the fee is not paid for two months continuously the student will be expelled from the school and he/she will have to take re-admission to sit into the class.

Student will be allowed to appear in the half yearly and final exams only when your ward have been paid till that date.

In case the student wants to migrate / leave the school, he will have to pay the entire year fees even if he/she has not attended the school for the whole year. In case of late admission, all the fees will be applicable as for a regular student and it will be essential to pay all dues before admission. Report Cards / T.C will not be awarded till all school dues have been cleared by the student.

Examination Pattern

Our School is following the new Examination pattern given by CBSE which has been divided into 2 parts *i.e.* Half Yearly & Annual Exams. Periodic Test Series will be organized in last week of every academic month.

Health
